Troop 354 - Leadership Position Guide





Description: The Chaplain Aide is responsible for supporting the spiritual and ethical development of the troop. This role involves assisting the troop's Chaplain (adult position) in organizing and leading religious services, prayers, and other spiritual activities during troop meetings and events. The Chaplain Aide also helps promote respect for various faiths and encourages Scouts to explore their own spiritual beliefs. This position provides an opportunity for Scouts to grow in their personal faith, while also fostering an inclusive, respectful environment for all members of the troop. By supporting the spiritual well-being of the troop, the Chaplain Aide helps Scouts live by the Scout Oath and Law in all aspects of their lives.

Responsibilities:

- help organize and lead prayers, religious services, and other spiritual activities
- encourage Scouts to explore their faith and partake in a Religious Emblem program
- serve as a member of the <u>Patrol Leaders' Council (PLC)</u>
- set a good example by <u>wearing the full Scout uniform</u>, living by the Scout Oath and Law, and showing Scout spirit
