## Responsibilities:

- guide younger Scouts through their first ranks and through patrol-based activities
- use the E.D.G.E. method to teach troop activities and procedures
- serve as a member of the Patrol Leaders' Council (PLC)
- set a good example by <u>wearing the full Scout uniform</u>, living by the Scout Oath and Law, and showing Scout spirit
