

Troop 354 – Leadership Position Guide

Position: *Historian*



Description: The Historian is responsible for documenting and preserving the history and memories of the troop. This role involves collecting photographs, news articles, and other memorabilia from troop activities and events, creating a record of the troop's journey and milestones. The Historian may also help with creating displays or presentations that showcase the troop's achievements and heritage. This position allows Scouts to develop skills in research, storytelling, and archiving, while also fostering a sense of pride and continuity within the troop. By capturing the essence of the troop's experiences, the Historian ensures that future generations of Scouts can look back on the rich history of the troop.

Responsibilities:

- collect and preserve photographs and other memorabilia from troop events
- help organize and present the troop's history through displays/publications
- serve as a member of the Patrol Leaders' Council (PLC)
- set a good example by wearing the full Scout uniform, living by the Scout Oath and Law, and showing Scout spirit
