Position: Order of the Arrow Representative



Description: The Order of the Arrow (OA) Representative serves as the primary liaison between the troop and its associated OA lodge: Mishigami 29, promoting awareness of OA programs, events, and service opportunities. The OA Rep ensures that eligible Scouts are informed about the OA's purpose as Scouting's "national honor society" and encourages active participation in its' activities. By fostering connections between the troop and the OA, the OA Representative helps Scouts understand the value of brotherhood, cheerful service, and leadership within the wider Scouting community. Additionally, this role encourages Scouts to embody the ideals of the OA and share their experiences to inspire others.

Responsibilities:

- share information about upcoming Order of the Arrow events, service projects, etc.
- encourage eligible Scouts to participate in OA activities and partake in training
- serve as a member of the Patrol Leaders' Council (PLC)
- set a good example by <u>wearing the full Scout uniform</u>, living by the Scout Oath and Law, and showing Scout spirit
