Position: *Quartermaster*



Description: The Quartermaster is responsible for managing and maintaining the troop's equipment and supplies. The Quartermaster's duties involve organizing and keeping inventory of troop equipment, such as tents, cooking gear, and other camping supplies. The Quartermaster coordinates the distribution and collection of equipment for troop outings, making sure that Scouts have the necessary items for their outdoor adventures. This role requires attention to detail, good organizational skills, and the ability to prioritize and manage resources effectively. By keeping the troop's equipment in top shape, the Quartermaster plays a crucial role in enabling Scouts to engage in enjoyable and successful outdoor activities.

Responsibilities:

- keep track of the troop's camping gear, ensuring accurate count and conditions
- oversee the preparation, distribution, and return of troop equipment
- serve as a member of the Patrol Leaders' Council (PLC)
- set a good example by wearing the full Scout uniform, living by the Scout Oath and Law, and showing Scout spirit
